REACH EG Nr. 1907/2006

The plastic machining company Alfred Schweizer GmbH & Co. KG is, in terms of REACH as a “post processing user” in general not a subject to registration requirements according to REACH. Therefore, products made out of plastic that you procure from us do not require a registration, in terms of REACH. Components contained in our products that might require registration can only be registered by our suppliers. As a shared concern we keep close contact to our suppliers to pursue the implementation of REACH. The main commitment of the post processing users consists in communicating along the supply chain. According to Art. 33 of the REACH regulation, it’s our responsibility to inform our customers, if our product contains substances of very high concern (SVHC) in concentration exceeding 0.1 percent by weight. Our suppliers are required to inform us immediately if products delivered to us contain SVHC in concentration exceeding 0.1 percent by weight, as well. If we receive any information concerning this matter we will inform you immediately.

Duty to inform in accordance with Article 33 REACH-regulation (EG Nr. 1907/2006):

The product PVC contains more than 0.1% following substance: Dibutyl tin compounds (DOTE) CAS number: 15571-58-1. There are no special precautions in the handling of the product required, as the substance is firmly integrated in the plastic and will not be released under normal conditions of use.
